I request this under the freedom of information act, S.C. code of law, Section: 30-4-30 and United States code Annotated, title #15, section: 55a

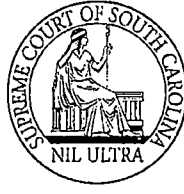

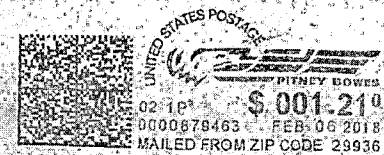
