

Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal does not appear to have been timely served as defined by Rule 262(b), SCACR.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, you must serve and file an amended notice of appeal in the format shown in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. You must include the names of both judges, correctly identify the court in which you are filing the appeal, name the parties as appellants and respondent, and include attorney information regarding opposing counsel pursuant to Rule 203(e), SCACR.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
