Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected in its entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed. This is the Court's second request for these corrections:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, this appeal is with the Court of Appeals, not the Supreme Court.
- The brief you filed appears to be a list of documents you wish to include in the record on appeal. The content of your brief must comply with Rule 208(b)(1) and be substantially in the format shown by Form 13 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief in which these corrections have been made within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
