QUESTION PRESENTED

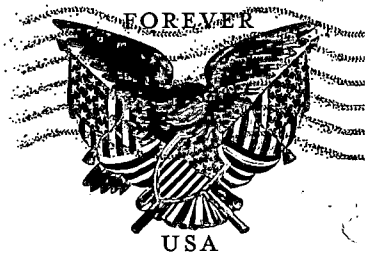
