Dear Mr. Hutchinson,

Pursuant to our conversation at the York County Detention Center, I filed an appeal from your guilty plea. In addition to filing the Notice of appeal, the SC Rules of Appellate Procedure require me to file a "written explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal." I wrote an explanation of the judge not allowing you to plead as indicted but I ask you write the court about any other issues you know of.
