Upon reviewing your amended designation of matter, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed. This is the Court's second request for these corrections:

- You must serve and file an amended designation of matter within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
