

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Appellant, through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully request unto this Court as follows:

1. The Final Brief of Appellant was due February 7, 2018 pursuant to Appellant's submission of the Record on Appeal on January 18, 2018.
2. Counsel for Appellant had previously filed a motion to extend the deadline for filing the Record on Appeal on January 17, 2018.
3. The Court graciously extended the deadline to February 16, 2018.
4. Upon receipt of this Order, Counsel believed the Final Brief would then be due 20 days after February 16<sup>th</sup>.



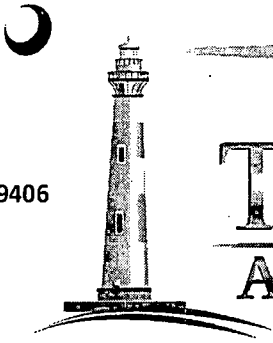
