Dear Counsel:

Please note: This is the Court's second request. Upon reviewing your appellant's initial reply brief and proof of service, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. It must name the document served – the appellant's initial reply brief. The proof of service refers to the appellant's initial brief. You must serve and file an amended proof of service.
- Pursuant to Rule 267(a) SCACR, only the name, address and phone number of the counsel submitting the brief is to be a part of the caption of that brief.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it must appear on future filings exactly as shown below:
