My name is Sharon Jones, the mother of **Eric English** who was represented by **Jason Chehoski** for a jury trial on **01/08-10/2018** in the Lexington County General Sessions court. I am writing in effort to make a complaint in reference to **INEFFECTIVE COUNSEL of REPRESENTATION** against **Jason Chehoski**. He willing and knowing lied to the courts about Eric's location and contacts. He did not make offer for appeal for Eric within 10 days as required of him by law. Mr. Chehoski has had some type of vendetta against my son from when we first learned he was appointed to represent Eric. We have made several attempts to talk with Mr. Chehoski concerning the outcome of Eric's case and we asked for DNA evidence; but he refused to return phone calls.
