ORDER

On October 11, 2016, this Court issued an order remanding this case in part to the court of general sessions for reconstruction of the record. Since that time, the Honorable W. Jeffrey Young has retired from the circuit court bench and accepted a position with the Office of the Attorney General. Counsel for the appellant asks this Court to appoint a new judge to oversee the reconstruction hearing. The State filed a return consenting to the appointment of a judge and requesting the appointment of a judge from the Third Judicial Circuit.

The Court grants the appellant's request. The State must turn over the requested discovery material to appellant's counsel within 30 days of the date of this order. The Court refers this case to the Chief Judge for Administrative Purposes for the Court of General Sessions of the Third Judicial Circuit to coordinate scheduling a hearing for the reconstruction of the record, if that is possible, before any available judge as expeditiously as possible. Counsel for the appellant shall immediately notify the Court upon the issuance of an order by the circuit court resolving this appeal. Counsel for the appellant shall also provide status updates every thirty days or the appeal will be dismissed.
