

ORDER

This court has construed Appellant's motion to stay all proceedings in this case as a request for an extension of time. The request for an extension is granted. This court has received a sufficient number of copies of Appellant's Final Brief and the Record on Appeal filed January 26, 2018. The only thing remaining for Appellant to submit is the supplemental record on appeal required by this court's August 31, 2017 order.
