Defendants Patricia Williams and Ronald Williams represented by Stacy Stanley, the Plaintiff represented by Douglas E. Leadbitter and the Defendant State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company represented by Linda Weeks Gangi came before this Court on the Defendants', Patricia Williams' and Ronald Williams', Motions for Reconsideration. The remaining Defendants are in default. The Court heard such arguments of counsel as was appropriate.

On November 1, 2017 the attorneys for these parties appeared before this Court on a Motion to Dismiss jointly filed by ACCC Insurance Company and State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurant Company. Patricia Williams and Ronald Williams objected to the dismissal. The parties were also before the Court on motions filed by Patricia Williams and Ronald Williams seeking to compel mediation and seeking to amend their answer to file a counterclaim. The Court heard the arguments of counsel. The Court indicated at the time of the hearing that the motion to dismiss was granted and the motions filed by the Williams were rendered moot by that decision. The Court directed that counsel for ACCC Insurance Company and State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance

Company prepare an Order consistent with its ruling. The Court executed a Form 4. Thereafter the Court entered a formal Order on November 15, 2017 finding that the Motion to Dismiss should be granted and the above-captioned action should be dismissed with prejudice. The Court in its Order also found that based on its ruling the motions filed by the Williams were rendered moot. Thereafter, the Williams filed multiple Motions for Reconsideration. This Court having heard the arguments of counsel, reviewed the Memorandums in Support and in Opposition, and reviewed its Order of November 15, 2017 finds that the Motions to Reconsider are hereby denied. The Order of this Court dated and filed on November 15, 2017 shall be law of the case.
