

ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from the Administrative Law Court's order denying Appellant's motion for summary judgment or for remand. Appellant has also filed motion to stay the contested case hearing and a motion to determine appealability. Because the ALC's order is not a final decision that is immediately appealable pursuant to section 1-23-610 of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2017), this appeal is dismissed. *See Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority v. South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 266-67, 692 S.E.2d 894, 894-95 (2010) (holding that judicial review may only be sought from a final decision of the ALC and explaining that a final decision "disposes of the whole subject matter of the action or terminates the particular proceeding or action, leaving nothing to be done but to enforce by execution what has been determined"). Appellant's motion to stay is denied.
