


ORDER



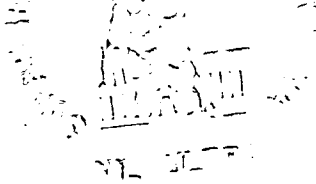
