
Dear Mr. Stozier:

As you know, the above case is pending before the South Carolina Court of Appeals and you are represented by counsel in this case. This Court has now received your request to enjoin the Department of Corrections from interfering with access to the law library and other legal supplies or services regarding the above case and another case.

Since you are represented by counsel before the Court of Appeals in the above appellate case, no action will be taken on this *pro se* request as it relates to that case. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989). If, of course you need an extension of time to file a *pro se* response to the *Anders* Brief submitted by your counsel in the above case, you should direct that motion for an extension to the Court of Appeals.

The other case is 2011CP4005698, a case that is pending in Richland County. Since you have not provided a certificate or affidavit of service showing that a copy of this request has been served the Department of Corrections as required by Rule 240(c)(1) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, no action will be taken on this request as it relates to this 2011 case.
