Upon reviewing your filing received on March 8, 2018, which is presumed to be a response to the Court's letter of March 2, 2018, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed. This is the Court's second request for these corrections:

- The title page does not comply with Rule 210(d), SCACR. Specifically, the title of the document being filed is the Record on Appeal, not the Designation of Matter. Also, the caption of the case must match exactly with the one below:

- The certificate of service provided is for the designation of matter. You must provide a certificate of service for the record on appeal.
- You must serve and file an amended record on appeal in which these deficiencies are corrected within ten (10) days from the date of this letter.
