
**MOTION TO ENLARGE TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF OF

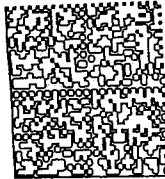
