Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR, I would refer to the following as additional authority:

As to Issue V: State v. Fley, 2Brev. 338, 345-46 (S.C. Const. App. 1821) (finding no distinction between a principal and accomplice);

State v. Hunter, 79 S.C. 73, 73, 60 S.E. 240, 240-41 (1908) (finding where defendant disputed the State's witness who claimed defendant fired the fatal shot, the Supreme Court affirmed the conviction because the identity of the shooter irrelevant and defendant was properly convicted since he was an aider and abettor).

"It would do well for defense counsel to remember that the people of the State as well as the defendant are entitled to a fair trial." State v. Stewart, 283 S.C. 104, 110, 320 S.E.2d 447, 450 (1984).
