



ORDER

This matter is before the Court by way of a petition for a writ of certiorari to review an order of the Court of Appeals dismissing the matter. The petition will not be considered for several reasons. First, pursuant to order of this Court dated January 30, 2014, petitioner may not proceed *pro se* in any court of this State except in the trial court in a criminal case in which she is the defendant. Because the petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter was filed by petitioner, not an attorney, the petition will not be entertained. Second, petitioner has failed to file an appendix as required by Rule 242(e), SCACR. Third, petitioner has failed to pay the filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR, in this appeal from an order of the circuit court denying petitioner's request for reimbursement of defense expenses under the South Carolina Defense of Indigents Act. This matter is therefore dismissed.
