MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Michael Lorenzo Green respectfully requests a **final** extension of thirty days **until April 18, 2018**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fifth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.

2. **This case was re-assigned to undersigned counsel on February 26, 2018 from Lara Caudy who is out on maternity leave.** Counsel for Michael Lorenzo Green respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension

of time. **Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.**

3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Arthur Rivers v. State in the Supreme Court on March 16, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of State v. Matthew Z. K. in this Court on March 12, 2018. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Dennis E. Cervantes-Pavon in the Supreme Court on March 8, 2018. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari to this Court in the case of State v. Marvin Brown in the Supreme Court on March 5, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dontavious Jackson v. State in the Supreme Court on March 1, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Ernest Bailey in this Court on February 26, 2018. Counsel testified during a PCR hearing at the Horry County Courthouse in the case of Julia Gorman v. State of South Carolina on February 21, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of State v. Anthony Maurice Wise in this Court on February 20, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of Wiley Sisk v. State in this Court on February 1, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jeron Alondo Cook v. State in the Supreme Court on January 22, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.






