ORDER

Appellant has served and filed a notice of appeal from the circuit court's order denying a motion to dismiss. Respondents have filed a motion to dismiss, contending the underlying order is not immediately appealable. After careful consideration of the parties' filings, the motion to dismiss is granted. *See Huntley v. Young*, 319 S.C. 559, 462 S.E.2d 860 (1995) (holding that generally the denial of a motion to dismiss is not immediately appealable); *see also McLendon v. South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation*, 313 S.C. 525, 443 S.E.2d 539 (1994); *Mid-State Distributors, Inc. v. Century Importers, Inc.*, 310 S.C. 330, 426 S.E.2d 777 (1993). The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
