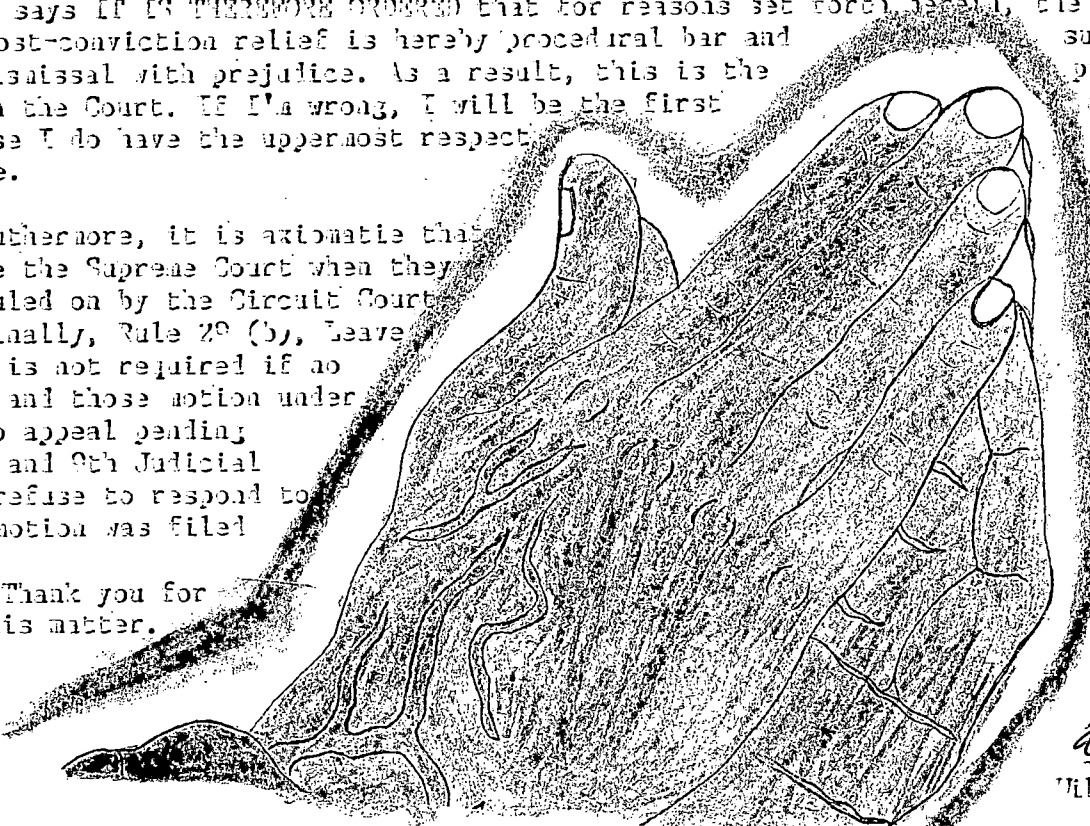
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that for reasons set forth herein, the Application for post-conviction relief is hereby denied and dismissed with prejudice.
