

ORDER

This matter is before the Court by way of a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the court of appeals' decision in *Winfrey v. Archway Servs., Inc.*, Op. No. 2017-UP-336 (S.C. Ct. App. filed Aug. 2, 2017). The petition is denied.


Also pending before this Court is a motion to compel payment of medical care as ordered by the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission. Based on our disposition of the petition for a writ of certiorari and the fact that the motion and return indicate there is a factual dispute regarding the payments respondent seeks in the motion, we find the request made in the motion is more appropriately made to the Workers' Compensation Commission. We therefore deny the motion without prejudice to whatever right respondent may have to raise the issue of the payments to the Commission following the sending of the remittitur by the Court of Appeals in this action.




