We are in receipt of your "Brief", filed on February 23, 2018, which is presumed to be a response to this Court's letter dated February 16, 2018. The following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The content of your appellant's initial brief must contain a table of contents and cases, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, argument, and a conclusion as required by Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR.
- The content of your brief is single spaced. You must serve and file an amended brief in which the type is double spaced, pursuant to Rule 267(c), SCACR.
- The first page of your appellant's final brief should consist of a title page in which the caption matches the caption given below as required by Rule 267(a), SCACR:

Nathaniel Alston, Claimant, Appellant,

v.

All My Son's Moving & Storage, Employer, and Vanliner Insurance  
Company, Carrier, Respondents.

- You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief, along with a proof of service, within ten (10) days from the date of this letter.
