## ORDER

Appellant was sentenced in these criminal cases in January 2015. An appeal was taken to the South Carolina Court of Appeals, and the Court of Appeals affirmed these 2015 convictions in an unpublished opinion.<sup>1</sup> When no petition for rehearing was received within the time specified by Rule 221 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur on April 21, 2017.

Appellant has now filed a *pro se* notice of appeal from the 2015 convictions. Since nothing in the Appellate Court Rules allows for the filing of successive appeals from a criminal conviction, this notice of appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221, SCACR.
