
To Whom It May Concern:

I, Tara Kay Maddox, am writing you to appeal a court decision made on the 29th of August, 2017 at Three Rivers Behavioral Health after having been admitted by a party that physically assaulted (lynched) me at my home address 307 Blueberry Drive, Lexington, South Carolina 29073. The offending party has been informed of my intention to sue for medical malpractice but has refused to stop harassing me and offending the nature for which permitting responsible care could be assumed. Medical malpractice is the civil term for which I engage your honorable court system; however, if allowed the time and courtesy for which this appeal poses by law, it is my intention to dispose of this order for mandatory attendance due to the fact I have other means in which to satisfy the need for professional care by my primary physician, and could provide medical records of my previous and ongoing attendance to these events for the past ten years. Darlington County is also out of county and jurisdiction for which it seeks to impose a rule of law for a 'Mentally Ill' person for 12 months; Defamation of Character is a crime in the state of South Carolina, and I have been very active in my mental and physical health for which records I would be able to provide to you of my willingness to attend these over the past ten years.

There is also a need for further discovery; security cameras, testimony, investigations into what lead to this terrorism in my life but a need for code enforcement and reviewing South Carolina law. There are much broader documents I also like to revere - like the Australian Constitution, which forbids home invasion; which, in this case, was the precursor to force medical treatment which included lynch, molestation, and the arbitrary arrangement in which out of county and jurisdiction would seek to impose hypothetical retainer for mentally ill person. I find the indictment process unconstitutional, and am by law allowed an appeals process to stop what for effortless means is to enforce itself might stand in court to defend herself even if it escalates to Supreme Court Justices. That medical malpractice and defamation of character is a crime, that Darlington county is out of it's jurisdiction and it's offending nature be made evident by reviewing the and that my need for an attorney and further council made present today at your honorable court system not be ignored. Thank you for your time and attention to this request. I greatly value the capacity to engage your honorable court system for an appeals process allowed by law are in appreciation of our civil rights

and constitutional rights.

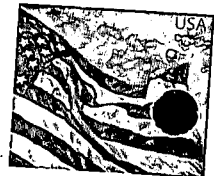
