Dear Mr. Bundu:

Upon reviewing your designation of matter and caption for the initial brief of appellant, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed.:

- The filing does not comply with Rule 209(b). You have failed to list the documents to be included in the record on appeal.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. It also must name not only to whom it is sent but to what address(es).
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the designation of matter is not headed by a caption.
- The caption page provided was titled "brief of appellants", not designation of matter. The name of the document should appear below the caption – not above it. It appears that the caption was provided for the initial brief of appellant. It is missing the word "Respondents" at the end of the caption. In addition, the appellant's contact information must be included on the caption

page.
