
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On February 12, 2018, Deborah R.J. Shupe sent a Motion requesting this case be held in abeyance in order to obtain a transcript from an on-the-record conference in chambers from Appellant's trial. On February 16, 2018, this Court issued an order holding this matter in abeyance pending receipt of the transcript, and the transcript was ordered.

After speaking with the court reporter, it became clear that the chambers conference had already been transcribed and was part of the original transcript. The court reporter clarified the location of the conference and indicated who was present in a revised transcript which was received today, March 22, 2018. Opposing counsel has indicated that the digitally-signed revised transcript is sufficient such that this matter does not need to be held in abeyance any longer.
