ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on February 20, 2018. Appellant never paid the filing fee for the notice of appeal or the petition for rehearing, and this Court sent down the remittitur on March 13, 2018. Appellant has now filed a motion, which this court construes as a request that this court recall the remittitur and reinstate the appeal. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because the remittitur was properly sent, this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.
