
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Appellant served Respondent with his Initial Brief on March 28, 2018 making Respondent's Initial Brief due April 27, 2018. However, in addition to his Initial Brief, Appellant served Respondent with a document titled "Voluntary Dismissal" which appears to be a motion to dismiss his appeal before this Court. Shortly after serving these document on Respondent, on April 2, 2018 Appellant was released from Respondent's custody. Respondent has no objection to the dismissal of this appeal but does request that the time for filing Respondent's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter be extended until 30 days after the Court rules on Appellant's "Voluntary Dismissal." No previous extensions have been requested on behalf of Respondent. This extension request is not being made for the purpose of delay.
