**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONDENT'S FINAL
BRIEF**


The Record filed by Appellant in this case did not include all relevant documents. Specifically, Appellant failed to include Appellant's eight sentencing sheets, the Conviction Summary from SCDC's Offender Management System, and the Inmate Offense History from SCDC's Offender Management System. Additionally, Appellant filed a Final Brief that was not identical to his Initial Brief. On February 16, 2018, Respondent filed a motion requesting that Appellant be required to file a corrected Final Brief and Record and that Respondent be given an extension of time to file Respondent's Final Brief in light of the issues with the Record. On March 29, 2018, the Court issued two orders the first of which made Respondent's Final Brief due on April 18, 2018. The second of the Court's March 29, 2018 orders requires that Appellant file a Supplemental Record by April 30, 2018. Respondent needs the Supplemental Record in order to

complete Respondent's Final Brief. Thus the Respondent requests that the time for filing Respondent's Final Brief be extended until 30 days after the Appellant files his Supplemental Record. This extension request is not being made for the purpose of delay.

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests that this Court extend the deadline for the service and filing of the Final Brief of Respondent in this case until 30 days after Appellant files the Supplemental Record.



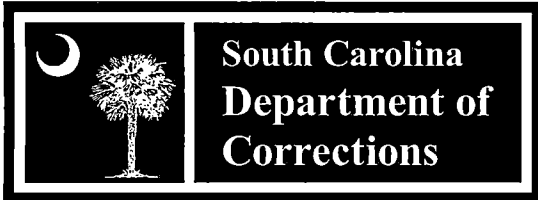

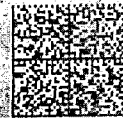
