

ORDER

After filing an opinion in this case, the South Carolina Court of Appeals denied a petition for rehearing on February 23, 2018. On April 3, 2018, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur to the circuit court.¹

By motion dated April 4, 2018, petitioner requests an extension of time to serve and file the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix to review the decision of the Court of Appeals. Since the sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, the motion for an extension is hereby stricken and dismissed. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).
