
Counsel for Respondent respectfully request's the Court's permission to amend the Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal. In support of this motion counsel shows:

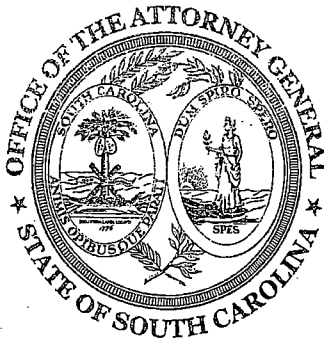
