**APPELLANT'S MOTION TO REDACT RECORD AND BRIEFS
AND
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Appellant moves this Honorable Court to allow the claimant in this workers' compensation appeal to be identified as "Jane Doe" in the caption, if the claimant's name appears at all in the caption, and in the parties' briefs. Appellant further moves that all personal identifying information about the claimant to be stricken from the record on appeal and the parties' briefs. See Rule 240, SCACR.


This appeal involves only issues related to the attorney's fee of the undersigned, who is the Appellant. The issues on appeal are whether the S.C. Workers' Compensation Commission erred in denying Appellant's motion to reinstate the appeal after it was administratively dismissed, as well as the denial of and issues raised in Appellant's motion for rehearing.

Appellant anticipates that some documents and underlying facts contained in the record necessarily will include information about the case of Misty A. Morris, the claimant. However, given that none of the issues involve the merits or outcome of the claimant's case, Appellant asks that, to the extent the claimant is identified in the caption, record or the parties' briefs, she be identified as "Jane Doe." Appellant also asks that the Court direct the parties to redact the claimant's name and all personal, identifying information about the claimant from the record on appeal and the parties' briefs.

Appellant served the notice of appeal on March 22, 2018, and his initial brief and designation of matter currently are due to be filed by April 23, 2018, because no transcript was ordered. See Rules 208(a)(1) and 209(a), SCACR. To the extent necessary, Appellant moves for an extension of time to file his initial brief and designation of matter until this motion is considered and resolved by the Court.

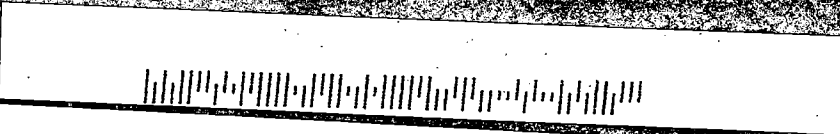
