**2<sup>nd</sup> EXTENSION REQUEST  
INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

I am requesting a 2<sup>nd</sup> extension for my Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. The first extension granted through April 18, 2018 unfortunately will not provide sufficient time complete my brief.

Although not an excuse, I am representing myself and understanding the Court of Appeals format and procedures has been thorough but time consuming.



The Appellant is attempting a restraining order as I am protesting a Hilton Head Hyundai Dealership and as such the 14th Circuit Court denied their restraining order injunction including their reconsider. Also, the Court of Appeals has denied their expedite requested.

I request and extension for the following reason:

I have been protesting in front of their business and my First Amendment Rights have been violated including: 3 signs stolen, a set of car keys, car breach – water drenching the inside of my vehicle, a stolen brief case and a Wal-Mart video recording their Security Vehicle following me to another premise (Harassment and Intimidation) and not to mention the vulgar, derogatory cussing directed towards me.

My efforts to stop this activity have failed including any effort from the local Authority, Jasper County Sheriff's Office, to intervene. Noted, I believe a conflict of interest as a few Jasper County Deputies are employed part-time by the dealership and present during some violations.

As I continue my activity in front of the Hilton Head Hyundai Dealership until the trial or the Court of Appeals overturns the 14 Circuit Courts Decision I requested SLED (South Carolina Enforcement Department) to review the past and ongoing injustices as such violating my First Amendment Rights. Including in their review, Jasper County Sheriff's Office behavior lacking any effort to protect my Rights. A SLED Executive Officer, Captain agreed to review my concerns.

Point of Reference, The violation of my first Amendment Rights are equally aligned with my concern for my personal safety!

The past few weeks I collected the data necessary for SLED to review my First Amendment Rights violations and Safety concerns including the Jasper County Sheriff's Office related behavior.

I have enclosed the associated Binder Index that is copied to 10 Agencies and/or legal authority. The indexed data is over 80 pages and was very time consuming as understandable it required accuracy and explanation.

Please approve an extension, minimum 3 weeks from April 18, 2018 or what the court deems necessary.
