Dear Counsel:

The Court received your status update indicating the parties have not been able to reach an agreement regarding reconstruction of the record. This case was remanded to the court of common pleas for the limited purpose of attempting to reconstruct the record. Our expectation is that the special referee who issued the order on appeal will issue an order detailing the results of the reconstruction hearing on remand. Within ten days of the date of this letter, you must provide a detailed update regarding your attempts to comply with the following provision in this Court's June 16, 2017 order: "Counsel for Appellant is ordered to contact counsel for Respondent and the special referee within ten days of this order to schedule such hearings as the special referee deems appropriate." The update should include the parties' communications with the special referee and attempts to set this case for a reconstruction hearing. If you do not respond within ten days of the date of this letter, your appeal will be dismissed.
