MOTION TO RECALL REMITTITUR

---

Appellant, Greenville Pharmaceutical Research, Inc., by and through counsel undersigned hereby moves the Court to recall remittitur issued on April 3, 2018.


A motion for an extension of time to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix was filed with the Supreme Court of South Carolina on April 4, 2018. At the time of that filing, the Order or Remittitur had not been received.

The extension of time was requested based on extenuating circumstances. The initial filing deadline was overlooked due to personal hardship. In a period of a few short months, both my parents passed away, I had to relocate my elderly step-father, and my assistant who kept my calendar, quit before calendaring some of my deadlines.

Appellant submits that the motion for an extension of time to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix was filed prior to the Appellants receipt of the Order of Remittitur on April 9, 2018. Based upon the filing of the Appellants motion with the Supreme Court for an extension of time prior to the Appellants receipt of the Order of Remittitur, Appellant submits that the Court of Appeals should have jurisdiction to recall the remittitur and that the Supreme Court should have jurisdiction to allow for an extension of time to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix. Wherefore, the Appellant moves to have the Court recall the remittitur in this case.


