Arrowpoint Capital Corporation, Appellant, appealed an Order of the Circuit Court affirming the Workers' Compensation Commission's denial of its claim for reimbursement from the Respondent South Carolina Second Injury Fund ("the Fund"). By opinion filed on May 31, 2017, this Court issued Unpublished Opinion No. 2017-UP-229, reversing the Circuit Court and the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission's decision denying reimbursement to Arrowpoint Capital Corporation from the Fund.

The Fund filed a petition for rehearing. By Order filed on August 18, 2017, this Court, after careful consideration, denied the Fund's petition for rehearing. Subsequently, the Fund filed a petition for Writ of Certiorari. By Order dated March 28, 2018, the South Carolina Supreme Court promulgated an Order denying the Fund's Petition for Writ of Certiorari.

By letter dated April 5, 2018, the matter was remitted by this Court to the lower court or tribunal. Counsel for Arrowpoint Capital Corporation received Notice of Remittitur on April 9, 2018.

Pursuant to Rule 222, Arrowpoint Capital Corporation hereby files a Motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222(A-E), with respect to the costs obtaining a copy of the transcript of the circuit court hearing; of printing final briefs regarding a petition for rehearing and petition for certiorari, and for attorneys' fees. The attached itemized statement of costs sets forth a total amount Arrowpoint Capital Corporation seeks and requests this Court to tax attorney's fees and costs against the Fund.




