This matter was called to trial on March 20, 2018. The parties advised the court that the Plaintiff had settled with the liability insurance carrier for the Defendant and the case was being defended by the Underinsured Motorist Carrier for the Plaintiff. The settlement was for \$25,000 in exchange for a Covenant Not to Execute.

The case was tried before a jury and the jury rendered its verdict after deliberation in the amount of \$7,000. Neither the Plaintiff nor the Defendant made any post-trial motions before the court after the jury was released (the court is aware that the Plaintiff has since filed a Motion for a New Trial on April 2, 2018). Pursuant to the terms of the Covenant, the verdict shall be marked satisfied of record. Therefore, based on the forgoing, it is

ORDERED that the jury verdict in the amount of \$7,000 be marked as satisfied on the public records of Horry County, and it is
