This responds to your document entitled "Appeal of Order of Dismissal." This document, which is dated April 16, 2018, was received by this Court today.

To the extent this document may be intended as a petition for rehearing regarding this Court's order dated March 22, 2018, no action will be taken on this petition for three reasons. First, since you are represented by counsel in this case, this *pro se* petition cannot be accepted for filing. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989). Second, the petition is untimely under Rule 221(a), SCACR. Third, the sending of the remittitur on April 9, 2018, ended appellate jurisdiction over this case. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

To the extent that you may be trying to seek appellate review of the decision of this Court, I call you attention to the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States
