To whom it may concern,

I am writing in regards to my SC Supreme Court appeal, case 2014-000764. Yes, it is 2018, and this case has been on appeal since 2014! The original oral arguments were heard June 2016, and a rehearing was granted without a decision which was heard February 15 2018. I would like to inquire about the status of my case and see if a bond petition has been filed by my attorney, C. Rauch Wise, following the rehearing. He'd expressed his intention to do so, but I have not heard from him since the rehearing, & he has not responded to any of my letters, emails, or inquiries from my family, so I have no idea if he is having health issues or what is going on. My late husband used to contact him for me with questions and concerns, but sadly, he lost his battle with Stage IV throat cancer on Dec 20 of last year - waiting for the resolution of my case and for me to come home. I was robbed of the opportunity to care for this man I loved more than life itself, during his final days. Now our 11-yr old son, Brandon, is essentially an orphan, without either parent to care for him. I am serving a 20-yr sentence for a crime that is physically impossible for me to have committed, and no one else in the entire world has ever been charged OR convicted of. This has been most traumatic and heartbreaking as I have been violated by the system & SCDC & kept from everyone & everything I've ever loved. My son desperately needs his remaining parent home with him as soon as possible. We've lost so much that we can never get back due to this wrongful conviction. This case has dragged on for an INORDINATE amount of time and I pray that the Honorable Justices show heart, mercy, and compassion and rectify this injustice very soon. Any information you can provide about the status of my case is greatly appreciated. Sincerely,
