


PETITION FOR EXTENSION

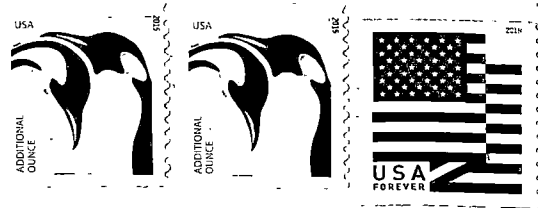
