 Motion for Summary Judgment**



On January 26, 2018, this Court entered an Order granting Summary Judgment in favor of Frances C. Welch and denying Christie MacConnell's Motion for Summary Judgment. Counsel for MacConnell filed a Motion for Reconsideration of that Order. The Court held a hearing on that motion on March 27, 2018.

After considering the filings and arguments of counsel, the Court AMENDS its prior Order to delete in its entirety Section 4 titled "Laches." The Court finds that when taking all inferences in favor of the non-moving party, MacConnell, it cannot conclude as a matter of law that MacConnell's claims are barred by laches as there are genuine issues of material facts.

The remainder of the Court's Order stands, and summary judgment is GRANTED in favor of Frances C. Welch for the reasons set forth therein.
