**AFFIDAVIT OF BETTY FISHER**

1. My name is BETTY FISHER, and I am over the eighteen and of sound mind. I am one of the plaintiffs in this case.
2. I have personal knowledge of the matters set forth herein and if called and sworn to testify, I could and would competently do so.
3. I intended to file this affidavit with my motion for new trial which I learned on April 3, 2018, two days before the deadline, I could not file.
4. At all times, I relied on advise of my counsel in prosecuting this case. As such, I believed that the facts supported the law in this case, and that the claims were warranted under


existing law or that an extension, modification, or reversal of law was available with regard to these legal proceedings.

5. Further, I believed based on my conversations with my aunt, Alice Shaw Baker, and that there were documents which supported my conversations with her that her estate was going to animal charities, that proceeding with this litigation was not only proper but consistent with her desires. It was my wish, only, to make sure that her desires were followed.

6. I did not intend EVER to delay, harass, or injure any other party. I was aware that my daughter Lisa Fisher was paying from her personal funds to maintain her [Alice Shaw Baker's] property, pay property taxes, pay insurance, and all other related expenses during the appeal process. I believed that these payments prevented waste to the property and allowed it to accrue in value, so that no losses to my aunt Alice Shaw-Baker's estate would take place.

7. I am requesting that the court preserve the status quo to protect Alice Shaw Baker's property, pending resolution of the appeal.
