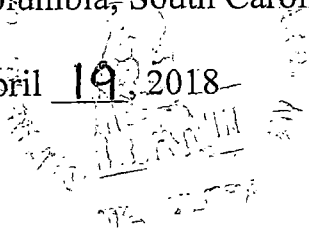
ORDER
