I was told that April 12 date would be rescheduled to May 29-June 1. I thought while it wasn't July, it would allow me some time to recover and finish classes. However, the next day I was told court date would be April 23-26 time period. As a result, I have had multiple anxiety attacks. I am currently on medication for anxiety.

I had already worked so hard to change schedule to accommodate June 1 date and then with it being changed so suddenly I would have to do more work and cancel and reschedule plans.

I have to see multiple doctors and specialist. I have numerous referrals and appointments to schedule and attend. I need to be able focus on getting better and completing school.

I have also experienced multiple anxiety attacks due to health and worrying about having to attend upcoming case. I asked that you work with me to reschedule in future, when I have completed school and in stable health.

I feel hopeless and like nothing I do makes a difference of matters. If I spend time on education, legally I suffer. If I attended to legal matters my education and health suffers. I need to be able to prioritize my health and education. I am dependent on financial aid and cannot jeopardize that. In order to push through with my medical needs, treatments, and appointments in addition to keeping up with assignment I need more time before case goes to court. This is taking time away from me getting medical treatment and help that I need. There is no real way for me to be prepared or able to go to court at this time. I would like your help and need to have at least the original date that I was told of May 29-June 1, or July at best.

Lakessiah Henderson

I have suffered from and have been treated for ADD, anxiety, depression, social phobia since the age of 14 or younger. I have trouble focusing or concentrating for extended periods.

I am currently on medication for pain and anxiety. The medicine often leaves me groggy

This year I was diagnosed with Emf sensitivity/ radiation poisoning, parasite infection, and heavy metal poisoning.

My symptoms include chest pains, not able to eat or drink without taking medication. I often have trouble breathing. I was thought to have esophageal issue such as acid reflux, and had to get multiple procedures such as multiple x rays, endoscopy, gastric manometry.

I have had to go the cancer institute, and have been hospitalized at least 4 times in past 7 months, in addition to hospitalizations the year prior.

I worry about having to be hospitalized again and have had multiple close calls.

I was given notice of eviction in magistrate court in Feb and had no choice but to go to court despite health conditions.

After court, I was given a writ of ejectment and had to file an appeal in two days or be forced to leave. I had to make multiple trips to courthouses at least three total to do appeal and attend a bond hearing.

Since then, I wrote a letter asking for continuance until July to allow time to take care of medical, education, needs. I was told that April 12 date would be rescheduled to May 29-June 1. I was finally able to relax and believe I could focus on health and finishing classes this semester. However, the next day I was told court date would be April 23-26 time period. The court case was scheduled without even checking with me about what date and time would be preferable within that time period. Which is what I had previously requested and had been in contact with Steve the Coordinator.

As a result, I am have had multiple anxiety attacks. I feel hopeless and like nothing I do makes a difference of matters. If I spend time on education, legally I suffer. If I attended to legal matters my education and health suffers. I need to be able to prioritize my health and education. I am dependent on financial aid and cannot jeopardize that. In order to push through with my medical needs, treatments, and appointments in addition to keeping up with assignment I need to pause my legal situation. There is no real way for me to be prepared or able to go to court at this time. I would like your help and need to have at least the original date that I was told of May 29-June 1. I had to change schedule to accommodate that date and then with it being changed I would have to cancel.



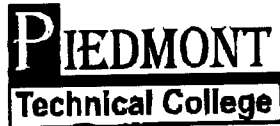
