

ORDER

Appellant has appealed an April 25, 2018 order by the circuit court affirming the magistrate court's ejectment ruling and remanding to the magistrate court. Appellant has now filed a motion asking this court to stay the execution of her ejectment. Although Appellant has not provided this court with a signed undertaking as provided by section 27-40-800(f) of the South Carolina Code (2007), she has provided proof of two March 2, 2018 payments: one to satisfy rent previously owed and one as a \$720 bond "for future rent." Accordingly, after careful consideration, the circuit court's April 25 order is temporarily stayed for fifteen days pending receipt of any return to the motion by Respondent and a signed undertaking, if any, by Appellant.
