Williams, James Coard, David Hoard, Julius Coard, Jr., Steve Coard, Victoria Coard, Queen Elizabeth Boyd, Lawrence Coard and John Doe, a fictitious person, representing as a class all unknown heirs of Albert Coard, Lucille Coard, Ransom Coard, Julius Coard, Willie Coard, Queen Elizabeth Coard (if deceased), Wilhemener Marion, Wilhemener Coard Mickens, James Baxter (if deceased), and Steve Coard and all other unknown persons claiming any right, title, estate, interest or lien in or upon the real estate described in the Complaint herein, and Richard Roe, a fictitious person representing as a class all persons suffering under legal disability and claiming an interest in the property herein described, Defendants,

Of whom Ranson Coard, Jr. and Patricia A. Coard-Seabrooks are the Appellants.

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. You must show timely service on opposing counsel as well as on the clerk of the lower court.
- We are returning all attached documents to you as filing them at this time is not in compliance with Rule 203, SCACR.
- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal which complies with the requirements of Rule 203, SCACR.
