Enclosed, please find a letter that I received from the South Carolina Court of Appeals.


I do not believe that there are any grounds for the appeal of your General Sessions charge but I filed the paperwork because you specifically requested that I do so. Therefore, you now have to provide the court with your own reasons for the appeal and you must show the court that any issues for appeal were preserved for review by the appellate court. This means that any issues you want to argue on appeal must have been objected to or placed on the record prior to or during your guilty plea.

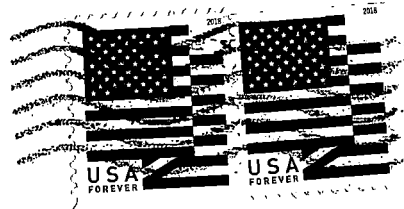
