**ORDER FINDING DEFENDANT  
IN CONTEMPT OF COURT**


This matter was before me on Tuesday, October 3, 2017. Defendant's case was on the trial docket and also pending were motions by the defendant and his attorney Carlyle Steele for Mr. Steele to be relieved as counsel for the defendant. I heard and granted those motions.

An Order of this Court dated June 14, 2017 relieved the defendant's previously appointed attorney Larry Cooke and ordered that should the defendant ask for subsequently appointed counsel to be relieved, he would have to proceed with his case *pro se*. Referring the defendant to that Order, the Court informed the defendant that his choices for proceeding were to have a jury trial, a bench trial or to plead guilty. The defendant was argumentative with the Court and would not indicate which of the three proceedings he was electing to go forward on. He then got on the ground and insisted on demonstrating what he alleged Department of Corrections Employees had done to him and was asked several times to sit at counsel table before he complied. The defendant continuously interrupted the Court and after being warned that he would be held in contempt if he continued to interrupt, insisted on interrupting the Court again.

Based on the defendant's disruptive conduct and refusal to comply with instructions not to interrupt the Court, I find that the defendant was in contempt of court and sentence him to 90 days to be served consecutively to the sentences he is now serving with the South Carolina Department of Corrections.
